All players that have not previously registered in the competitive, traveling club soccer program are required to purchase a uniform set. The total cost per child to register is \$120, \$55 for registration and \$65 for the uniform set which includes a home and away jersey, shorts and one pair of socks. The club attempts to re-use uniforms from season to season, so long as they can be purchased from suppliers. Please see the back of this form to order your child's specific uniform size, and if needed, any additional socks.

Registration forms and fees are due by February 1st, 2010. After this date a \$10 late fee will be assessed. Multiple child discounts are available. Registration fees **CANNOT BE REFUNDED** after February 1st, 2010.
